An Interfaith Journey for Justice: Reflections from the U.S./Mexico Border

At the beginning of December 2022, Valerie Carlisle and Taylor Holbrook joined Journey for Justice, a special experience sponsored by Witness at the Border. The caravan traveled from the Gulf of Mexico to the Pacific



Ocean. Val and Taylor walked and witnessed - and will share their profound reflections during our Annual Meeting.

Valerie Carlisle is a retired Poughkeepsie City teacher and is currently an activist for immigration justice issues. She is treasurer of Grannies Respond and a member of the local group, Reunite Migrant



Families, which formed to protest the separation of families at our southern border and now works providing emergency aid to the local Hispanic community.

Taylor Holbrook, a retired minister in the Reformed Church in America, spent 32 years in ministry looking for ways God was breaking out inside the church. Since 2018 he has been looking for ways God is breaking out outside the church. He is a DCIC board member, a participant in Reunite Migrant Families of Dutchess and Chair of the Dutchess County Interfaith CROP Walk.
